In this course, the trainers will learn not only the main concepts about eLearning pedagogy and online teaching, but also they will enjoy "in their own skin" the experience of on-line education, now by being students.

We are producing 10 ICT-based activities in following areas:

- Collaboration and sharing knowledge
- Analyse, understand, problem solving
- Collective discovery, learning together
- Knowledge management, sharing and growth

Our main aim is to facilitate transferability, so trainers can adopt those activities in their own subject / course.
